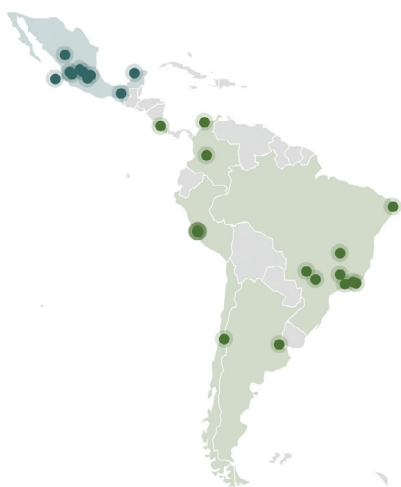


Tree Cities of the World
